The Left Party makes a difference

For nearly 100 years the Left Party has worked for justice and equality. We have fought for a society without class divisions, where there is equality between men and women, characterized by sustainable solutions. We have shortened the work week to 40 hours even though the right wing parties said it was impossible, we joined together and constructed a tram network through the city making it possible to get around without a car and our battle has resulted in the expansion of community-level child and elderly care so that women can participate in the workforce.

In area after area, the Left Party has made a difference.

In Gothenburg, we have removed the preschool queues, strengthened the right to full-time employment and continued to even out the wage gap between men and women. But we still have a lot left to do in our fight for a just and unified Gothenburg.

The results of 30 years of right wing policies, which escalated during the conservative government, are long waiting periods for housing, an uncertain job market with high unemployment, diminished welfare, with increased class divisions and a less equal society.

We therefore continue our work for justice and equality. We have long-term visions, but also concrete and practical solutions.

This is how we make a difference in the labor market:

- Pilot project with 6-hour work days with the same pay
- Right to full-time employment in the municipality
- Ban on private temporary employment agencies

Fair working conditions

We want everyone to have a secure job with reasonable pay. We therefore want to ban private temporary employment agencies that create insecurity, with universal temporary employment becoming the norm. We also want to change the standards for working hours to 6 hours per day with the same pay and give everyone the right to work full-time.

Right to housing

The housing shortage means that many are overcrowded and that young people cannot move away from home. There are simply a huge shortage of inexpensive housing alternatives in Gothenburg and we want to change that. We want housing units to be allotted according to waiting time, not according to wallet or last name. And we would like to increase safety in our residential districts through feminist development planning and investments in neglected neighborhoods.

This is how we make a difference in the housing market:

- Wait time as the allotment principle for residential units
- Safe residential areas
- More inexpensive public rental apartments

This is how we make a difference in schools:

- Removing preschool queues
- Offering all students tutoring
- Reducing class size

A school to rely on

Now that preschool queues have been removed, we want to focus on reducing the size of preschool classes. The Left Party also want all children to have an equal education by allocating school resources according to need. All children that need help will receive tutoring and all girls in junior high school will be offered classes in feminist self-defense.
